Chamber music ensemble Immersio Vienna is excited to announce the inaugural Ukrainian edition of the Immersio Vienna Academy, a series of chamber music seminars that will take place during the 2025/2026 concert season at the National Philharmonic of Ukraine. This program is a collaboration with the Youth Academy of the National Philharmonic of Ukraine and is supported by the OeAD-Kooperationsbüro Lemberg and the Ukraine Office Austria at the Austrian Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

Selected participants will immerse themselves in the chamber music repertoire for various formations and will develop their skills of group music-making, refine their artistry and polish their technique. Structured around four intensive seminars under the guidance of Immersio Vienna Academy mentors the program will also give its graduates a possibility of future concert appearances in Ukraine and abroad.

Their teaching activities include masterclasses in Austria, Germany, Mexico, Spain, Portugal, U.S.A., Chile and beyond.

As recorded artists, musicians of Immersio Vienna are constantly expanding their discography and videography or repertoire, that spans from masterpieces of Vienna Classics to lesser known creations or never before recorded works.

The Immersio Vienna Academy program features both lessons for ensembles, as well as individual coaching sessions, lectures and discussions.
